ITEM SUMMARY

Staff wishes to discuss with Council its thoughts regarding proposed revisions to the Prescott City Code, specifically Prescott City Code 5-9-1 through 5-9-6, concerning camping on City property, Section 5-1-3 which are defenses to prosecution for violation of curfew for minors, and Section 5-10-2, relating to the City's aggressive solicitation ordinance. The proposed revision to the code includes alternative versions of the Camping Ordinance for the Council to consider, and smaller changes to the City's curfew and aggressive solicitation ordinances. These revisions include a revised definition of camping, further guidance on enforcement, procedures for the disposal of abandoned property, and the recitals that serve as the basis for the proposed modifications.

BACKGROUND

These provisions of the Prescott City Code were last revised in 1998. The proposed revisions serve to bring the code up to date as well as provide the necessary background and information required to enforce such provisions.
