MINUTES

1. CALL TO ORDER

Chair Wiens called the meeting to order at 3:30 p.m.

MEMBER BRIGGS MOVED TO APPROVE THE MEETING MINUTES AS PRESENTED, SECONDED BY MEMBER NICHOLS: PASSED (4-0)

- B. Discussion & Possible Action Regarding a Proposed Peace Pole Donation from Robert Shegog.

Robert Shegog spoke about his donation for a Peace Pole at the City Library. He described the proposed peace pole construction and lighting and gave a description of the installation of the pole. He also described an International Day of Peace celebration with the peace poles.

Member Nichols asked about the number of poles in the city to which Mr. Shegog stated that there are four that he knows of within the city.

Chair Wiens asked about the installation to which the proposer hoped that the city would install the pole.

Vice Chair Briggs asked about the origin of peace poles and Mr. Shegog responded that he believed they originated in Denmark. Mr. Shegog showed photos of various peace poles to the committee.

Library Director Mellissa Orr spoke about the possible donation and stated that the library was working on a plan for art donations and currently would like to decline the offer. She discussed the maintenance of current art pieces and the

current inventory. Ms. Orr stated that the library would like to put donation requests on hold until they can get a plan in place.

Member Briggs stated he didn't think this piece met the current art donation policy.

Member of the public, Ralph Hess, spoke about the art donation and possibly having it come back in the future for reconsideration and possibly placing it in another location in the city.

The committee discussed the art donation policy and the scope of the committee.

Member Nichols suggested that Mr. Shegog come back with art created by a local artist and different location options in the city for the placement of the peace pole.

MEMBER NICHOLS MOVED TO TABLE THIS ITEM TO A FUTURE MEETING TO ALLOW THE REQUESTOR TO REVISE HIS DONATION REQUEST TO INCLUDE A LOCAL ARTIST AND AN ALTERNATE LOCATION FOR PLACEMENT, SECONDED BY MEMBER SNYDER: PASSED (4-0)

4. UPDATES


A. Staff Announcements

This item was for discussion only. No formal action was taken.


5. ADJOURNMENT
